**'I am the Way, the Truth and the Life.**

**No one can come to the Father except through me.**

**If you know me, you know my Father too.**

**From this moment you know him and have seen him.'**

**'To have seen me is to have seen the Father.'**

What is it that really satisfies us? Where do we find our true fulfilment? Philip, in today's gospel, goes halfway to the true answer: 'Lord, let us *see the Father* and then we shall be satisfied.'

On the one hand, those words express a deep insight. Seeing God face-to-face – that is to say, knowing him as he really is, experiencing his love and loving him in return in a total union of mind and heart – this is the one thing that can truly satisfy.

In everything we do, we are searching for fulfilment, in some way searching for our heart's desire; and Philip has that insight that once we see God, then that will fulfil all our desires.

We remember the words of St Augustine: 'You have made us for yourself, O Lord, and our hearts are restless until they rest in you.' (*Confessions* 1, 1, 1) We were created for the vision of God. So: Philip has it half right: 'Lord, let us *see the Father* and then we shall be satisfied.'

Yet he still does not see what is before his eyes. So Jesus says to him, 'Have I been with you all this time Philip, and you still do not know me?' In all his time with Jesus, Philip has not realised that in Jesus, the Father is already revealing himself in the greatest way possible in this life.

To understand that, it helps to recall what the Church's reflection has understood about the relationship between Jesus and his Father. In the Scriptures Jesus is also called the Word, and theologians have understood that God the Son is somewhat like the 'self-expression' of God the Father.

We each have an idea of ourselves, a self-image; and in a mysterious way, we can also think of God the Father as having an eternal perfect Idea of himself – so perfect indeed that his Idea is also God, in fact a person, in every way equal to the Father, and One God with him. And that 'Idea', that Word eternally coming forth from the Father, is God the Son.

So at the appointed time, the Eternal Word of the Father, God the Son, takes to himself a human nature, becoming flesh and living among us as Jesus. The One who is the perfect Image of the Father in the 'world' of eternity, in the world *beyond* time, now becomes the perfect Image of the Father *within* the world of time.

God reveals himself to us in the closest possible way, by becoming one of us. So in seeing and knowing Jesus, we do truly know the Father. So Jesus tells Philip, 'If you know me, you know my Father too. From this moment you know him and have seen him.'

That helps us understand the words Jesus had spoken earlier to Thomas: 'I am the Way, the Truth and the Life. No one can come to the Father except through me.' If the destiny God has planned for every person is to see him face-to-face in eternal life, the beginning *[continued p. 4]*

and the seed of that eternal vision has to be somehow seeing him face-to-face *in this life*. And we do that by literally seeing God with a human face – seeing him, and being united with him in a relationship of faith and love.

Even those who never have the opportunity of knowing Jesus explicitly in this life can only reach heaven if by divine grace they are somehow united with him in a hidden way.

Jesus Christ is the absolute centre of salvation, the One Saviour of the whole world, the only way to the Father's house for every human being.
